

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONS FOR CATECHESIS OF CENTRAL AMERICA AND MEXICO



Starts **today** in **Puebla** (Mexico), the **meeting of the Commissions for Catechesis** of the national Bishops' Conferences of the **Countries of Central America and Mexico**.

Promoted by the Pontifical Council for Promoting the New Evangelization, this meeting in Puebla is the first in a series of meetings in the different ecclesial macro-regions through which the Dicastery aims to make a survey on the state of catechesis in the world, in line with its mission.

Today and tomorrow, therefore, the **Superiors of the Pontifical Council** - archbishops Fisichella and Ruiz Arenas with Undersecretary Msgr. Bell - will meet the **leaders of the Commissions for Catechesis** of the Bishops' Conferences of **twelve countries** (Antilles, Costa Rica, Cuba, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Puerto Rico and the Dominican Republic), **together with the Archbishop of Puebla**, Msgr. Víctor Sánchez Espinosa, **President of the Department for Mission and Spirituality of CELAM** (Latin American Episcopal Council) , and the Executive Secretary P. Felipe de Jesús León de Ojeda.
