

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONS FOR THE CATECHESIS OF THE BISHOPS' CONFERENCES OF EUROPE

Rome, January 27-29



It was held in Rome, January 27 to 29, at the headquarters of the Pontifical Council for Promoting the New Evangelization, the **Meeting of the Episcopal Commissions for Catechesis** of the Bishops' Conferences of Europe.

Participated in the meeting the **Superiors of the Pontifical Council**, the **bishops presiding the Episcopal Commissions for catechesis** and the **heads of national catechetical offices** of 18 Episcopal Conferences (Albany, Belgium, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, England and Wales, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Scotland, Slovakia, Slovenia and Spain), along with a representative of the Turkish Bishops' Conference. The **Council of European Episcopal Conferences** was represented by Msgr. Djuro Hranič, *President of the Council for the Catechesis*, and Rev. Michel Remery, *Vice-secretary general* of the same Council.

This meeting was the second in a series of encounters in the different ecclesial macro-regions, after the one held in Puebla, Mexico, concerning the Latin America. By means of such meetings, the Dicastery aims to make a survey on the state of the catechesis in the world, in line with its mission.

During next months, therefore, other similar meetings will take place, in order to achieve a complete survey about the themes and challenges for the Catechesis throughout the world.
